- Report to Program Director for job responsibilities; Club Manager for employee issues.

Qualifications:

Coaches & Instructors must hold a valid US Sailing Level 1 or higher, First Aid and CPR certifications, NASBLA and SafeSport certification. Have familiarity with the boats in our fleet: Power: 18' Brigs, 18' Boston Whalers. Sail: Prams, Optimis, Club 420s & RS Quests.
