Thanks for your good presentations over the past month(s).

- I am the Program Director of the Buzzards Sailing School (Cape Cod, MA), and also the Board President. I recently presented to our families how I envision our program being run. We do have a few details to work out nearly all of which are applicable to all clubs. I was hoping that US Sailing could assist with research and guidance as it is information that is going to be helpful to thousands of sailors in a month.
- Social distancing it will be up to clubs to follow state guidance on social distancing. This will have implications for multi-handed boats. I don't think US Sailing wants to get involved...but it is a constant question. (Some say what if parents sign waivers to allow it. But this can't be permitted if a state says no.)
- Face coverings I plan to require face coverings for all sailors and staff when on land. This will be like wearing a life jacket on the water = non-negotiable. The question is what kind of covering is appropriate? Cloth masks with ties around the back are ideal for land can get them snug, etc. Medical masks around the ears not as good for kids due to size and the gapes at the end. But they are quicker and easier.
- Assistance/safety If an instructor needs to physically touch a student (or get very close) is it enough to simply pull the buff over their nose? Would they require a "better" face covering?
- We have 4-6 weeks -- perhaps some resources could be directed to getting better answers to these questions. I am sure in the US Sailing community there are doctors, nurses, etc. who could take the lead. (And yes I know there are legal implications but I hope we can put those aside and just present information not "guidelines/mandates/suggestions". I feel that avoiding these questions due to liability is more dangerous than trying to address them.)
- 20:28:22 From gjb7755 : I recommend Bill Bearce @ Bearce Insurance if you have insurance questions.
- 20:28:31 From David Korb: Disinfection of equipment: would boat soap and water (either salt or fresh) be advisable to wash down equipment on boats i.e. tillers, main sheets, etc. How many minutes should they be scrubbed? Would we need lysol, bleach, etc.? Do Opti sails/masts have to be cleaned daily or just the higher touch points?
- 20:28:57 From David Korb: Buffs the unknown. I have read that they are not as good as a mask as they are thinner. They are more comfortable and stay up pretty well which are positives. My hope is to require buffs only. We live in 24 unit apt building in Boston and thus have been wearing masks daily. I have been wearing a cloth mask with ties and a buff over it. It works great -- the mask is snug and the buff holds it in place well and closes any gaps. I don't think we can have kids do

this b/c they would then have to touch their faces to pull the buff down to remove the mask to sail. Then where would they store their mask? And then they would have to put it on upon arrival. Thus, I think a buff only is the "best" compromise. Should we require a certain thickness? Double buff? etc.?

- 20:29:14 From David Korb: On-water sailing if boats are 2-3 boat lengths apart face coverings are (assumingely) not needed. If we are doing Opti starts or mark roundings should sailors wear their buffs? I don't want them wearing cloth masks on the water. The buff might be a good compromise? The unintended consequence is that they will be touching their faces to put it up/down, but they probably touch their faces plenty on the water due to, spray, itches, salt water, etc. Should we make them wear buffs all the time on the water?
