Results from the scrimmages do not have any immediate effect however may be used to pre-rank teams for the SMSA Season TR Championships.

HOST CLUB RESPONSIBILITIES

The host club plays a critical roll in ensuring a successful and productive day of team race training. It is the Clubs' responsibility to have i) twelve (12) 420s prepared and ready to rig by the Report Time, ii) 2 motor boats, iii) 4-6 marks, and iv) meeting place. Lunch and water for guests is not required.

VISITING CLUB RESPONSIBILITIES

Visiting clubs must arrive on time and with a whole team. Visitors need to arrive with lunch and drinks and be prepared to eat, and otherwise spend long periods, on the water. Visiting clubs are strongly encouraged to send their race coach to contribute to, and take from, the experience.

SMSA SEASON CHAMPIONSHIP

The SMSA Team Race Championship is open to any Club in SMSA, one team per Club. In order to qualify for entry a team must have participated in at least 2 of the following events:

- 1. A Level SMSA clinic #1 and/or #2,
- B Level SMSA clinic.

- 3. The VHYC Team Race day and/or.
- 4. The CJ Buckley Team Race Regatta (in RI).

The Championship event will have no regatta cap, however teams are required to bring their own boats.
