- 3. Regional Symposium: As I write this, US Sailing is hosting the first ever Sailing Leadership Forum February 6-8, 2014 in San Diego, CA. To quote from their website, "This groundbreaking event will connect leaders from all aspects of our sport such as sail training and education, yacht club and sailing organization management, racing associations and organizations including one-design and handicap classes, race officials, and industry professionals."
