Info For Competitors:

1. Report Time is 9 AM Saturday June 26. If this is altered for some teams based on an elimination format, these teams will be contacted directly. Make sure you are there on time. We will have coffee, donuts, etc. for you. Please bring your own lunch.
2. MAKE SURE YOU HAVE YOUR FORMS WITH YOU! Your entry form must be completed and IT MUST BE SIGNED BY A FLAG OFFICER! YOU MUST HAVE A COMPLETED AND SIGNED MEDICAL FORM FOR EACH SAILOR! Med form is attached. Link to registration form is below (ignore the 2009 date and use this form anyways) –

3. Report to Chatham Yacht Club. Directions:

Take Route 6 East to exit 11.

At the end of the ramp turn left onto Route 137 toward Chatham.

Take an immediate left onto Pleasant Bay Road.

Follow Pleasant Bay Road to the end, going straight through one stop sign.

At the end of Pleasant Bay Road bear right onto Route 28.

Pass Pleasant Bay and enter Chatham, see the sign.

At the top of the hill take the first road on the left - Fox Hill Road.

Follow Fox Hill Road for approximately .7 miles. Eastward Ho Country Club will be on your left. Turn left into the first entrance, with a sign for Chatham Yacht Club Parking.

From the parking lot, walk up to the main clubhouse, then turn right and walk around the building and down the hill to CYC – follow the signs. **Wait politely and silently for any golfer about to tee off or putt** as you pass the 1<sup>st</sup> tee and 9<sup>th</sup> green. Parking is limited,

please minimize the number of cars you bring – carpool or get dropped off if possible.

4. The format for the event will be a complete round robin in Flying Scots.
5. We will not have spectator boats available, though the racing can be viewed from shore. According to the Championship notice of race: “competitors shall not receive advice, instruction, or any other type of outside assistance including using electronic communication devices while at the sailing venue.” And in the Championship conditions: “It is the intent of this rule to prohibit contact between competitors and any person who, in the opinion of the Protest Committee, is a coach, instructor or advisor during . . . the race day.” The Conditions of the Junior Nationals Championships has changed this year, so we are trying to get

clarification on this rule; if possible, we would like to allow coaches to work with their kids.

6. If you are unable to send a team or if you have any trouble on your way to the site. Call the event chair (John Dickson, 508-274-7367) IMMEDIATELY!
7. Island teams can ask for housing. Please contact John Dickson (508-274-7367) to inform as to if and when housing will be needed.
8. The Flying Scots will be available for practice from 1-4 on Friday, June 25, 2010. Please contact John Dickson (508-274-7367) if you would like to participate. For this practice, report to PBCB at Jackknife Beach, NOT TO CYC. (find directions at <http://pccb.cc/pdfs/Directions.pdf>)
