Duxbury Yacht Club, Duxbury MA, is seeking to hire a Director of Sailing for the summer of 2021.

The Director of Sailing at the DYC participates in developing and overseeing quality Junior and Adult programs intended to teach sailing in a fun, safe and nurturing environment which both follows US Sailing guidelines in a creative and thoughtful way and works within the unique Duxbury Yacht Club environment.

The Director of Sailing includes a 13-week full time position from June 15 through September 7, as well as off-season deliverables including staff hiring, program development, fleet management and scheduling as needed over the year to execute and oversee our 9 week Jr sailing program, adult learn-to-sail program. Duxbury Yacht Club serves 50+ kids ages 8-16 who learn and compete in Optimists and 420s, as well as the adult membership. In addition to managing the junior program activities, a primary goal of the position is to increase member engagement with Duxbury's unique waterfront environment through a fun and effective curriculum.

Responsibilities Include:

- Hire, direct and supervise staff
- Directly communicate with parents and junior sailors
- Directly communicate with Sailing Chair/Jr Sailing Chair
- Oversee and participate in curriculum development for juniors /adults
- Oversee and participate in fleet maintenance
- Oversee and participate with on and off the water teaching and mentoring

The Ideal Candidate will:

- Have Jr Sailing Instruction and program management experience
- Be US Sailing Level 1 certified at a minimum, Level 2 or 3 preferred
- Be knowledgeable of all aspects of Sailing, Regattas, Etiquette, and Corinthian Sportsmanship
- Have a complimentary lifestyle that would enable potential long tenure in the position.
