Sailing Center Manager: The Jetties Sailing Center is the site of various youth and adult programs, including sailboat and windsurfing instruction as well as rentals in kayaks, paddleboards, and a variety of large and small sailboats. In addition to instruction opportunities, NCS offers community outreach as well as a disabled athlete program. Job responsibilities would include, but not be limited to: running the site on a daily basis, managing upwards of 15 staff members, overseeing the various programs held on-site, and working with the Program Director to ensure the success of the site and its programs. The site manager should be a proficient sailing instructor, as well as have a working knowledge of windsurfing and kayaking. Candidates should have US Sailing Level 1 certification or its equivalent at minimum, and a college degree. Nantucket Community Sailing's Jetties Sailing Center includes Rhodes 19s, Marshall Cat 15's, 420s, RS Visions, Sunfish, and Lasers. Job responsibilities would include, but not be limited to: leading the Intermediate Class on a daily basis, assisting with the Optimist Race Team and Beginner classes, traveling with the Optimist Race Coach to off-island regattas, and working with the Program Director to build the program and ensure its success. Candidates should have significant racing and coaching experience and have a minimum of US Sailing Level 1 certification, or its equivalent.
