The host club needs to provide a coach or instructor who is able to set the Digital N team racing course and manage a round robin rotation. Ideally, a double round robin is run. Visiting clubs must arrive on time and with a whole team. Visitors need to be prepared to sail immediately upon arrival, and spend a long period, on the water.
