

SMSA Optimist Championship - 2010

The *SMSA Optimist Grand Prix Championship* was organized in 1991 to encourage competition amongst the junior sailors of SM Sailing in the International Optimist Dinghy. The *SMSA Grand Prix Optimist Champion* will be an individual with the highest cumulative score from seven junior regattas. A competitor must only compete in one of seven events to qualify for Championship Points.

Requirements for entry in the *SMSA Optimist Grand Prix Championship*.

1. It is the responsibility of each competitor to ensure his or her name, sail number and club is spelled and listed correctly at each event. SM Sailing is not responsible for correcting individual event data that gets reported incorrectly.

2. Entrant must be a current member of a club/organization belonging to SM Sailing. An entrant will only be scored for the events occurring after membership is SM Sailing has been established.

3. Championship Points will be calculated on the following formula:

$$((N - F + 1) / N) + B = \text{Event Championship Points}$$

N = Number of Competitors in event

F = Finish Position

B = Bonus (1st - .4, 2nd - .3, 3rd - .2, 4th - .11, 5th - .06, 6th - .02)

4. Ties will be broken in this order:

A. Who beat whom more in head to head competition.

B. If there is a tie in Championship Points between two or more boats, the tie will be broken in favor of the boat that won more regattas in the series, or, if the tie remains, the most second places, or lower places if necessary, using only the scores for each boat that count for her Championship Points.

C. Co-Champions will be awarded.

4. The winner of the *SMSA Optimist Grand Prix Championship* will be done by divisions (red, blue, white). The winner of each division will be the entrant with the most Championship Points after the completion of the seven event series. Only the top five scores will be scored towards a competitor's final Championship Points Total.

5. If an entrant should age out of a Fleet during the season, that entrant will continue to be scored in the Fleet that they were first scored.

6. A competitor need only compete in one event to be eligible for Championship Points.
