The Scituate Recreation Department is seeking a Program Director for our Community Sailing Program. The Recreation Department teaches Mercury & 420 Sailing for beginner/intermediate junior sailors and a J24 Sailing program for adults. Applicant must be a skilled sailor with prior sailing instruction experience and knowledge of the three types of boats we use. Must be motivated, organized, and communicative while demonstrating the ability to work with and lead a staff of 10 counselors. Necessities include Maritime/Harbor Safety, Boat handling and understanding of minor repairs and rigging boats. Essential to know how to operate a motor boat. This position is non-union and non-benefit eligible. It is a seasonal full-time job starting mid-late June and ending the first or second week of August. A typical week runs Monday thru Thursday 8:00 am – 4:00 pm. Pay rate ranges from \$25.00-\$36.00 an hour based on ability and qualifications.
