NAME OF EMPLOYING ORGANIZATION: Wild Harbor Yacht Club

BREIF OVERVIEW OF ORGANIZATION:

The Wild Harbor Yacht Club is located in North Falmouth, Massachusetts, on the shores of Buzzards Bay. Our program is conducted over an 8-week period, and annually enrolls 120 students ages 7-18, beginner to advanced. We teach; Opti's, 420's, Hunters, Sunfish and Lasers. There are two racing coaches and five senior instructors who are supervised by the Program Director.

The overall objective of the program is to teach children the skill of recreational sailing, as well as racing. As sailors progress through our program, a secondary objective is to build strong racing skills through our Optimist, Laser and 420 Race Teams.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- 18 years old and/or graduated High School.
- Level 1 certified, including an approved safe boating certificate, CPR and Basic First Aid. *Certification will be reimbursed by WHYC.*
- Familiarity with motorboats, Motorboat Safety Certification preferred.
- Previous experience as a Race Coach, *or* significant race experience plus one year as a Senior Instructor
- Sound judgement on safety of classes pertaining to weather and sailing conditions.
- Ability to work well as part of a team.
- Ability to manage classes on and off the water and on rainy/no sailing days.
- Highly organized with an enthusiasm for teaching.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Develop and maintain a strong rapport with Program Director, other instructors, parents and WHYC Sailing committee.
- Work a 5-day/week schedule from start of season to the end.
- Travel to SMSA and Non-SMSA sailing events (regattas and team racing) throughout the summer. May include weekends.
- Management and day to day administration of assigned classes.
- Responsible for assisting in maintenance of Club-owned Hunter sailboats, Sunfish, coach boats, Yacht Club and grounds
