You must be 18 before June 20th 2021.

A strong background in sailing and racing

A current First Aid/CPR certification

Three references

Previous experience coaching sailing is a plus.

Preference will also be given to applicants with lifeguard certification and US Sail certification (level one or higher).

The regular summer program runs from June 21st through August 27th with set up, training, and orientation the week of June 16th. A small staff will continue through until Sept 15th. Instructors are scheduled from 9:00 – 3:30 and 4:30 to 7:00, Monday through Friday, evenings, and weekends. There is normally a generous 1-hour unpaid lunch period.

Employees can use kayaks, paddleboards, and sailboats when off duty.
