The Junior Sailing Program aims to provide the foundation for a life-long love of sailing through teaching sailing skills, sportsmanship, and competitive racing. HPYC offers classes for students ages 6-18 in Optis, Beetle Cats and 420s. We are seeking qualified individuals who can help create and run a sailing program that is safe, fun and instructional. The ideal candidate will be a team player who is excited to teach students of all levels and experience and who meets the following criteria:

- Has the ability to be located on the Cape from Mid June to Mid August (this position begins June 19th and ends August 18th)
- Is available to work M-F from 9-4.
- Has current US Sailing Level 1 Certification or Foreign Country Equivalent
- Current First Aid and CPR Certification
- Is comfortable working with a variety of ages and abilities?

Daily Responsibilities

- Arriving to work on-time and in uniform, including preparation of gear for foul weather sailing.
- Curriculum development each week, including daily lesson plans and weekly progress reports.
- Prepare classroom chalk talks to explain the on-the-water activities each day including drills and games.
- Caring for HPYC sailboats and coach boats
- Proper filing of incident/injury and damage reports daily

This position reports to the Program Director. Must be at least 18 years old to apply and have 2 or more years of experience in safe sailing practices. Experience working with youths is preferred.
