The team will be representing that RSA and must be made up of sailors from that RSA. All must be current members of US Sailing. Sailors must turn 19 in the calendar year.

Only one entry per RSA will be considered. Resumes will be evaluated on the following criteria.

- 40% Sailor Criteria how many major events have they done in the past three years; number of races in these events, number of attendants
- 20% Qualified through a regatta at the Regional Sailing Association level
- 20% Class Criteria size, diversity, depth and activity of class they normally sail nationally
- 10% sailors under 30 make up 25% of the team
- 10% female sailors make up at least 25% of the team
