Overview:

The Woods Hole Yacht Club is a small club located in Great Harbor in Woods Hole, MA. Our Sailing School is predominantly a learn-to-sail program. We teach in Mercury keel boats and Hartley12's. We offer group lessons for kids and private lessons for both kids and adults.

A Sailing Instructor's primary duty is teaching students (both children and adults) to sail safely and correctly in group and private settings. A Sailing Instructor will implement curriculum as guided by the Head Instructor and Sailing Master. A Sailing Instructor will act as a role model for their students, demonstrating respect for people, equipment, and the sport of sailing.

Qualifications:

1. Strong background in dinghy sailing and racing
2. Level 1 US Sailing Small Boat Instructor Certification, or equivalent
3. Current First Aid/CPR certification
4. Proficiency driving a small powerboat
5. Previous experience coaching sailing is a plus

Responsibilities:

1. Assist in setting up boats before the program begins and in taking down boats when the program ends
2. Teach the provided curriculum in accordance with US Sailing
3. Assist in filling out daily reports, recording weather, attendance, weekly practice plans
4. Responsible for teaching and enforcing proper care and storage of all equipment and boats
5. Maintain a professionally cordial environment by being prompt, responsible, and respectful
6. Abide by the zero tolerance policy regarding alcohol, tobacco, or any illegal substance or non-prescribed drugs
